How do Langham books impact Bible Colleges?

More Students **232** students (FT & PT) at each school

More Courses **37**% of courses use Langham books

School Library FACTS

- Average library has 10,865 books used by 160 students
- 50% have dedicated librarian among 26 FT & PT school staff
- 25% need on average 2,081 more books to be accredited
- 41% can't offer a course because they need \$986 for books

^{*} Results contain a 3% margin of error and 95% confidence level from 310 surveys completed during Summer 2016 by Bible colleges and Seminaries in 67 countries. Top 3 & Bottom 3 outliners were removed so that numerical averages would better reflect the typical size and impact for the 599 libraries served in 2015.
