

Equipping emerging leaders

Passionate young students and grass-roots preachers are given training, skills and support to step up and be the leaders God has called them to be in their communities. Our programmes which equip emerging leaders are **Student Sponsorships** and **Preacher Training**.

Multiply

Multiplying the ministries of senior leaders

Senior leaders are sponsored for Masters and PhD studies and are pastorally supported. This enables them to take their leadership to the next regional level: equipping and influencing hundreds of others. Many also exercise significant influence through their writing. Our programme which multiplies is **Faculty Training**.

Resource

Bridging the resource gap

Poverty means limited access to learning resources for leaders to interpret and deepen their understand of Scriptures, and then to teach others. Leaders are supplied with a wide range of learning resources. Our programmes which resource are Campus Development, Organisational Development & Volunteers, and Literature & IT Resources.

Care

Compassionate action

Leaders living and ministering in contexts of poverty and pressure have few – if any – financial reserves in the event disaster strikes. Existing ministry partners are supplied with relief aid if their geographic area is hit with a disaster of significant proportions, enabling them to bring profoundly practical leadership to their communities. Our programme which cares is **Humanitarian Development International (HDI)**.
